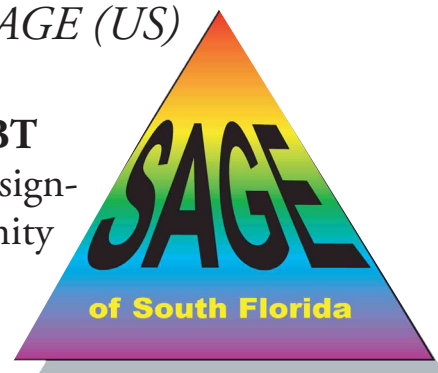

## *LGBT Forward Movement in Federal Policy*

*Karen Taylor, Director of Advocacy & Training SAGE (US)*

**We've seen four major areas of improvement for LGBT older adults** (in the last months of 2009)...the passage and signing...of an **inclusive hate crimes bill**, the funding opportunity for a **national resource center for LGBT elders**, and the **Department of Housing & Urban Development's push for anti-discrimination** and a **federally funded study of discrimination against members of the LGBT community in the rental and sale of housing**.



The vision and work of the **National LGBT Aging Roundtable** really helped to drive the work that has resulted in these victories, especially the **DHHS announcement of funding for a national LGBT elders resource center**. This is an exciting moment: the funding will establish a **resource center similar to those already funded in the African-American, Hispanic, Asian-Pacific Islander, and Native American communities, and positions the LGBT community as a population with particular social needs**.

Many members of the **Roundtable are looking at the DHHS announcement with great excitement**, and many are brainstorming, planning proposal development, and thinking about coalition-building....As with the recent AoA funding for the LA Community Center's

aging in place initiative, this will be an opportunity for Roundtable members to step up, put our best work forward, and shine.

**SAGE and the Task Force** will continue to press the Administration on Aging on behalf of the Roundtable for further administrative procedures and rulings to ensure inclusion of LGBT language as doors continue to open.

**"Outing Age"** (see last month's Newsletter) is being readied for print, and distribution to SAGE affiliates. 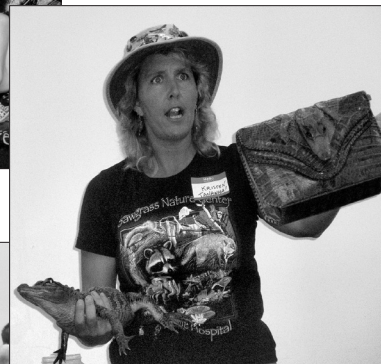

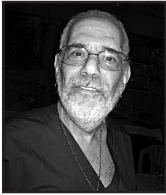

# SEE YOU AT THE MOVIES

## Carl M. Galli & Ken Goodman



Our **February 15, 2010** film is **“For a Lost Soldier”**. Released in 1993, it was one of the most controversial films of its time. But with American and Allied troops once again spread thin throughout wars in foreign lands, it is as relevant today as ever. Based on an autobiographical novel by **Rudi van Dantzig**, and written for the screen by **Don Bloch**, this is a gay coming-of-age story of a romantic relationship between a grown-up and a child. Set in the Netherlands during the Allied liberation of Holland near the end of WWII, the film is a flashback recalling an adolescent relationship” between **Jeroen Boman** (alternately

played by international star **Jeroen Krabbé** as the adult/narrator, and **Maarten Smit** as the young Boman) and a Canadian soldier (**Andrew Kelley** as Walt Cook). Now a choreographer, Boman, in the present, is attempting to incorporate his experience in a new ballet celebrating the Liberation. “A difficult subject handled with style and feeling” by director **Roeland Kerbosch**, who went on to win the **1993 Torino International Gay & Lesbian Film Festival for Best Feature**.

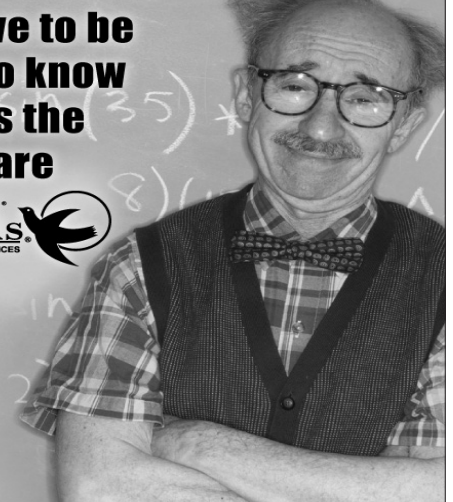

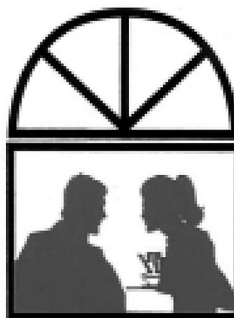
