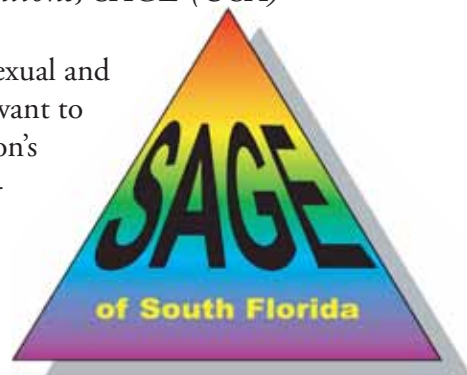

## *President Rules in Favor of LGBT Hospital Visits*

“On behalf of Services and Advocacy for Gay, Lesbian, Bisexual and Transgendered Elders (SAGE) and our affiliates nationwide, I want to thank President Obama for his leadership and his administration’s dedication in improving the lives of LGBT elders.” “The Presidential Memorandum released April 15 to Health and Human Services (HHS) Secretary Kathleen Sebelius, removes a terrible barrier faced by many of our growing LGBT aging elders - the fundamental right to care for those they love during medical emergencies.” “The President’s actions give dignity to many LGBT elders and other older Americans and it is a powerful step in removing the stigma, bigotry and isolation many LGBT elders face as they age.”



“As the world’s oldest and largest non-profit agency serving LGBT older people, our caseworkers have encountered countless and often tragic stories of LGBT persons being shut out of the hospital room or denied the opportunity to care for a loved one - often relationships decades long - because of discriminatory rules and regulations against same-gendered partners. In a medical emergency or an end-of-life moment, LGBT older adults are forced to call 911 then look for their power of attorney, if they have one.”

The Presidential Memorandum directs HHS to ensure that all hospitals that participate in Medicare or Medicaid respect the rights of patients to designate visitors, including individuals designated by legally valid advance directives (such as durable powers of attorney and health care proxies). Same-gendered partners should enjoy visitation privileges that are no more restrictive than those that immediate family members enjoy regardless of race, color, national origin, religion, sex, sexual orientation, gender identity, or disability. (The regula-

tory change will require HHS to propose new rules for public comment before final rules changes are made.)

“Without complex and often expensive legal arrangements in place, LGBT elders’ partners or other loved ones may be shut out of medical decision making or denied visitation.” “While the President’s authority does affect hospitals that participate in Medicare and Medicaid, I hope that other private and state run health facilities will follow the President’s leadership in ensuring the rights of LGBT Americans, particularly our older adults.”

“It is heartening to see a growing awareness of the inequities and disparities that many LGBT elders face in our society.”

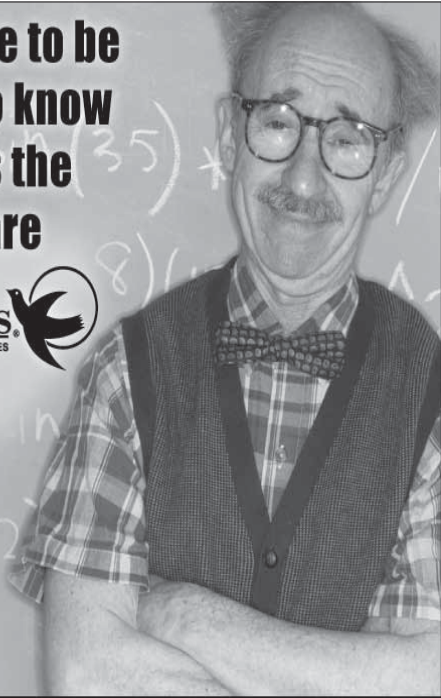
