## Meet Your New Board Members

### **Marc Flanagan, LCSW** (*Pompano Beach*)



Mr. Flanagan began his career as a Licensed Clinical Social Worker in 1998 with Life Care Home Solutions Home Care. In his capacity as social worker he provided social service evaluations, counseling and patient advocacy. He has also worked for Friends of Children, The Institute for Family Centered Services as an Assessment Specialist, and presently serves as a medical social worker for Gentiva Health Services.

Mr. Flanagan is a member of the National Association of Social Workers (NASW), is an American Red Cross Disaster Mental Health volunteer in Broward County Chapter, and is facilitator of a support group at Pride Center here in Ft. Lauderdale. He is also Club President and a Gold Communicator of Toastmasters International.



### **Inez Pasher, MSW** (*Wilton Manors*)



Ms. Pasher has had extensive experience in the working world, both as a clinical microbiologist, and as a representative for the Federal Department of Labor for 27 years. In that capacity, she evaluated state, municipal and county programs receiving federal funding.

While working for the Department of Labor, Ms. Pasher also volunteered with Community Board #1 in Brooklyn, New York, serving for 17 years. As a Board Member, she served on the Executive Board as Recording Secretary, and also chaired the Environmental and Solid Waste Management Committees. While performing her duties as a member of the community board, she was also Chairperson of the Environmental Benefits Program, and chaired the Watchperson and Newtown Creek Advisory Board projects. She has testified before Congress and other governmental agencies.

Ms. Pasher was one of the founders of Essex County Daughters of Bilitis and Essex County NOW in New Jersey. She has also been active in other gay and lesbian organizations, including the National Gay Task Force.

### **Bruce Williams** (*Miami Beach*)



Mr. Williams retired in 2006 as Executive Director of Treemont of Houston -- a Continuous Care Retirement Community consisting of 330 Independent Living Apartments, 54 Assisted Living Suites, 70 Licensed Skilled Nursing Beds and upwards of 200 employees. As a volunteer he served in areas as diverse as The Business Development Board of Sterling Bank (Houston) to The Board of Directors for The Country Playhouse.

His previous employment includes Acting Director of Social Work Services at St. Luke's Hospital in upstate New York where Mr. Williams was the creator of the nation's first hemo-dialysis units and kidney harvest/transplant teams.

Following his father's death from early-onset Alzheimer's Disease, Mr. Williams raised three siblings and cared for his mother until her death. Now retired, he hopes to utilize his experience -- both of a personal and professional nature -- to improve conditions for aging LGBT Seniors. Toward this goal, he currently serves on the Pride Center's Senior Advisory Council.

### What is CarFit for the older driver?

CarFit is an educational program that offers **older adults the opportunity to check how well their personal vehicles "fit" them.** The CarFit program also provides information and materials on community-specific resources that could enhance their safety as drivers, and/or increase their mobility in the community.

### Why is CarFit important?

Older drivers are often the safest drivers in that they are more likely to wear their seatbelts, and less likely to speed or drink & drive. **However, older drivers are more likely to be killed or seriously injured when a crash does occur due to the greater fragility of their aging bodies.**

Driver safety programs improve adult driver safety by addressing cognitive abilities and skills. ### How is a CarFit check completed?

At a CarFit event, a team of trained technicians and/or health professionals work with each participant to ensure they "fit" their vehicle properly for maximum comfort and safety. A CarFit check takes approximately 20 minutes to complete.
