SAGE (US) Applauds the Administration for Taking Steps to Improve the Health of All LGBT Americans.

The Department of Health and Human Services (HHS), on April 1st, announced steps to significantly improve the health and well-being of lesbian, gay, bisexual and transgender (LGBT) Americans, including an announcement (effective immediately) to notify states that they are empowered to treat same-sex domestic partners the same as married heterosexual couples when it comes to protection from "spousal impoverishment" under Medicaid.

# SOCIAL NOTES

Oh, WOW! What a couple of months **SAGE** had in March and April! In addition to our usual events and activities, almost every weekend was filled with **SAGE-Sponsored Social, Cultural and Educational** events for members and the community at large. If you look over your calendars, you will see that March could rightfully be called a “**SAGE Month**” -- among other sobriquets.

Of course, it was the **SAGE Reception** at the beautiful penthouse home of **SAGE (US)** members **Jim Stepp** and **Peter Zimmer** that kicked it all off with a glamorous bang.

Then, **PrideFest 2011** came over two days, and the **SAGE** booth, (strategically located down the row from our friends from the Boardwalk), was always busy. Of course, several board members were present for the volunteer training, as well as **Pinky**, **Barbara**, **John Gearrity**, (he gets around), **Ted Verdone**, **Susan** and **Toni**, and **Rob Saunders**. And the next, **HOT and DRY**, day saw us all out in the field behind the **Pride Center** imparting what we had learned to members and others from the community. Nearly **40 seniors** were educated, thanks primarily to **SAGE**.

The next weekend saw another community event -- a classical music concert sponsored by the **SAGE Men's Drop-In Group**, under the leadership of **Ron Catena**, and the artistic direction of **Dr. David Goldberger**. This was an overwhelming hit. Well over 100 attended (I stopped counting at 123) at the **Hagen Park Community Center in Wilton Manors**, to hear a special musical program featuring **The Four Doctors -- Dr. Deric Bownds, Dr. David Goldberger, Dr. Carl Ratner, and Dr. Mark Staebler** -- on piano, cello, and fantastic baritone. **Wilton Manors Commissioner Julie A. Carson** was on hand to lend her support for **SAGE**, congratulate the performers and thank the crowd for attending. (**SAGE** presented **Certificates of Appreciation** to the Four Doctors as well as to **Ron Seidle** and **Fred Vega** for their generous financial support, and to **Ron** for pulling it all together.

The next day saw what **Joyce B. Edelson**, (a **Founding Member**), called “the best party **SAGE** had had in a long time”:
