## A Timeline of Accomplishments

*A Message from SAGE (US) Executive Director  
and Board Co-Chairs*

As we reflect on the past year of historic achievements, it's clear that 2010 was a time of tremendous growth for SAGE and great progress in our mission to transform the quality of life for LGBT older people. Yet despite the ways in which we continue to advance and grow, it is striking how close SAGE remains to the determined, inventive spirit of our earliest years.

More than 30 years ago, LGBT older people needed a place where they could be themselves—whether they had spent a lifetime making their way out of the closet, or were still trying to figure out how or if to come out later in life. SAGE was founded in New York City as a safe space where LGBT elders could build community, ad-

vocate for their own needs and receive LGBT-affirming services that were denied in all walks of life. As the country's first organization to focus on LGBT aging, SAGE's work from the beginning was characterized by a streak of innovation born from the experiences, struggles and wisdom of LGBT elders.

Today, this innovative spirit has spread outward—from SAGE's local roots to its growing presence across the country. Innovation is at the heart of our current programs and services, which reach thousands of LGBT older people each year in New York City. It also runs through SAGE's increasing impact in communities across the nation through SAGENet, our nationwide affiliate program. And as the number of LGBT elders in this country grow, our programs evolve to keep pace with their changing needs. For example, we have introduced new programs, replicated across the country, that support LGBT caregivers in need of help and train LGBT mature workers who are seeking to stay relevant in today's tough job market. And innovation is a thread woven through big SAGE convenings such as last year's first-ever national conference led by, for and about LGBT older

people.

**Innovation is at the heart of the new National Resource Center on LGBT Aging. Launched in 2010, the publicly**

**funded National Resource Center represents the first-of-its-kind recognition by the federal government that LGBT elders have unique needs and government has a responsibility to help address them.** SAGE has provided steady leadership in building the National Resource Center with 10 partner organizations, including key stakeholders such as the American Society on Aging and National Institute of Senior Centers. The National Resource Center's mission—to provide training and information to service providers and LGBT older people across the country—has been bolstered by visionary philanthropic support from the Gill Foundation and the H. van Ameringen Foundation, creating a truly innovative public-private partnership to benefit LGBT elders.

Innovation also characterizes SAGE's federal advocacy work, where our strong leadership is helping to transform the country's public policies on aging so that they are LGBT-inclusive. In the past year, SAGE established a Federal Relations office in Washington, DC, and strengthened our relationships with the White House, the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services and the Administration on Aging. SAGE continues to build its partnerships and innovative collaborations with other aging organizations. We are the only LGBT member of the influential Leadership Council of Aging Organizations, and are a leader of the national Diverse Elders Coalition, which brings together organizations like the National Hispanic Council on Aging and the

# SEE YOU AT THE MOVIES

with John Gearrity and Carl M. Galli



Remember when you first saw *Catch Me if You Can*, with Tom Hanks chasing DiCaprio half-way around the globe? How entertained you were. And how incredulous. Surely it couldn't be true. BUT IT WAS. And that was at a time of National Innocence. Now comes our **Monday, September 19th** film, *I Love You Phillip Morris*, and you will be entertained and once again unwilling to believe, especially in this new era of high tech security. BUT IT'S ALL TRUE.



Steven Russell (played by **Jim Carrey**) is a happy family man, married to Debbie (**Leslie Mann**), and a member of a local Texas police force when a car accident triggers a dramatic mid-life crisis: Steven becomes open to his homosexuality and decides to live life to the fullest -- even if it means breaking the law. Steven's new, glamorous lifestyle involves cons and fraud and uber-extravagant trips to Miami Beach; and, yes, eventually a stay in the State Penitentiary where he meets sensitive, soft-spoken Phillip Morris (**Ewan McGregor**, in another one of his pantheon of gay and bi roles). His devotion to freeing them, and building the perfect life together, prompts Steven to attempt and often succeed at one seemingly impossible con after another. But multiple law enforcement agencies are on his case. And being a true story it ends realistically.

Co-Screenwriters of *Bad Santa*, **Glenn Ficara** and **John Requa**,

re-team for this fact-based dark comedy, which they also directed (and which Carrey co-produced).

From IMDb.com: "It's more unique than rare that a film affects me this much. The center, the emotional center of *Phillip Morris* has entered my subconscious in a way that I can't quite describe. It changed my perception of things...Here I was part of it, of them. I'm sure Jim Carrey and Ewan McGregor have a lot to do with it. No cheap shots, no low comedy. They are so true that you can't help loving them and rooting for them, flaws and all. I predict *I Love You Phillip Morris* will become the sleeper of 2009." Which it did, in Europe, where it more than recouped its modest 13 million dollar budget. It took another year to come to the USA where it was trimmed by about five minutes, doing well for an independent gay-themed film.

Nominated for several cinema awards, it recently won the **2011 GLAAD Media Award for Outstanding Film in Limited Release**. Come to our screening, on **Monday, September 19th at the Pride Center**, and be entertained -- and maybe have your perceptions changed.

*I Love You Phillip Morris* is rated **R** for sexual situations, adult language, and brief nudity.

It runs 98 minutes, leaving us enough time for dinner afterward.

# Occasional Thoughts

Last night I had a dream about life after gay marriage, and here's a little about the dream.

In my dream I saw a great big cul-de-sac.

Around this circle were nice houses with two-car garages. There were lots of children playing around, but the only ones I remember were the ones going up and down the driveways on their bicycles. (No doubt this is terribly symbolic.) In my dream all the people were white, but after I woke up and was visualizing what I had seen, a black family sort of slid in on the lower left side. I don't know what happened to all the people in between white and black.

That's all I saw in my dream, but somehow I knew that this was a picture of a nice middle-class neighborhood after gays had been marrying for some time. It didn't look futuristic, though, so it must be a time within our imagining.

I've been thinking what life might be like after we get full marriage equality. I'm thinking that for women it probably won't be too far from heterosexual marriage. Although almost everybody today looks kind of butch, I'm sure mother-1 and mother-2 will settle into some kind of roles, just as they do today without marriage.

One of the things that keeps jumping into my thinking about all this is whether a mother could go to school and request a Lesbian teacher. I suppose the guys might want a gay teacher too. I say Lesbian, but would it depend upon the sex of the child? Maybe. We'll see. But I digress.

Woman-woman pairings with children are common enough now that probably few people will pay much attention to them after marriage. But male-male families are something else. I don't expect

that there will be too many of them. Even in the age of AIDS, most men don't settle down until they're a little older than the women. Of course, we (meaning women) used to think that men couldn't have long-term relationships, but I sure do know a lot of them, so obviously we were wrong.

Anyway, I see men doing a lot of adopting. Having the baby with your own semen is wonderful, but surrogates are difficult to find, expensive, and unreliable (mothers tend to bond with their babies after they're born). I said that I thought that woman-woman pairings would be much like heterosexual marriage. I wonder if gay men will still marry in order to have children with their own DNA. If things turn out pretty much like I expect them to, there won't be any revolutionary changes. (I'm not ready to speculate on what kind of evolutionary changes there may be in the next few centuries.)

When we talk about full-marriage equality, we sometimes shorten it to full equality. Unfortunately, as in my dream, we generally think about people like us. Even when we have friends and acquaintances of other colors, we tend to think of them as being like us. One of the women in SAGE is black and refers to herself as the fly in the buttermilk, but to me she's part of the buttermilk. I'll bet that she doesn't always see it that way. I guess this is a round-about way of saying that we're great at wanting rights for ourselves as gay people, especially white gay people, but we usually see only skin-deep. Our oppression has not led us to be empathic about other people's oppressions.

A straight friend of my asked me how I felt about gay marriage. I said that for me, right now, I didn't know. But if I were young and in love, I'd probably get married and have kids.

One last thought: we're going to miss being part of a subculture.

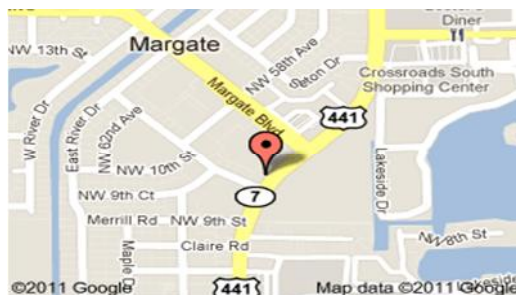
