# Breaking News

## From SAGE (US)



Robert Espinoza

SAGE's Senior Director of Policy & Communications, **Robert Espinoza**, delivered a powerful and personal speech at the **TransFaith in Color 2011 Conference**. The Conference, presented by the **Freedom Center for Social Justice in Charlotte, North Carolina**, aims to train a cohort of transgender people of faith to work as grassroots activists and opinion leaders around issues of sexuality within their respective faith and general communities. Additionally, the Conference strives to provide resources and technical support to educate, develop appropriate strategies and increase networking opportunities for transgender people as they build, grow and mobilize around relevant personal and policy issues.

Throughout the speech, Robert discusses the **challenges facing LGBT older adults, focusing specifically on the health issues confronting transgender elders and communities of color**. Robert shares the stories of his parents whose struggles as aging people of

color inspire him to vociferously advocate for the rights of marginalized populations of older adults.

Ultimately, Robert suggests that a **key strategy for improving the social landscape for LGBT older adults and people of color is to build strong coalitions that unite people based on shared experiences**, "We must form the types of coalitions that transcend the issue silos, the destructive single issue politics, the "my-issue-is-more-important-than-yours" mentality. These types of coalitions broaden both our understanding and our responses to some of the most difficult questions of our time."
