In summing up this article, as your President, I plan to take our excellent organization and continue its growth and success. Thank you all for your support and ideas.

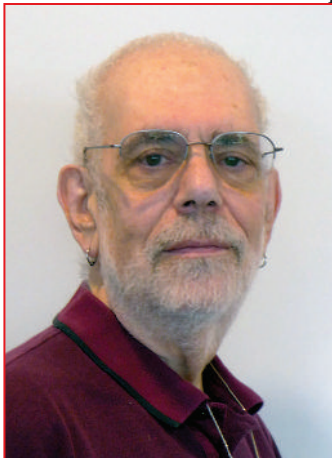

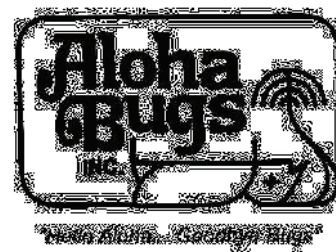

SEE YOU AT THE MOVIES

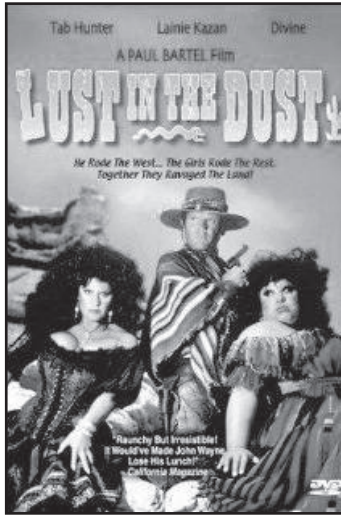
